

JON THORNER'S LTD RULES FOR ANGLERS:

The true value of this site is its unique, quiet, secluded location in the midst of the countryside. It provides a haven for wildlife and we sincerely wish to maintain its values and unique qualities.

We kindly request that all visitors therefore strictly observe our Rules that not only protect the fishing environment and wildlife but aim to protect all visitors and the freedom that visitors are able to enjoy.

GENERAL RULES

All anglers & guests must complete a Booking Form and pay at the Farm Shop / Reception, at Jon Thorner's head office, prior to going to the lake to fish. If money is collected on the bank you will be charged double.

All anglers (over 12 years) must hold a current and relevant EA Licence.

Please keep to the track when driving to / from the lake. Do not drive across the fields.

All vehicles must be parked in the car park (exception: wheelchair users).

Anglers and guests are responsible for their own vehicles, parking of vehicles and all their own property. Jon Thorner's shall not be held responsible for any loss, damage and/or injury to angler, guest or their property.

Children (under 16) must be accompanied by a responsible adult (over 18).

No pets. No swimming. No fires. Glass containers are not allowed. No antisocial behaviour at any time.

No alcohol allowed on site. Please use headphones for radios, iPods, MP3 players cassettes etc.

Please do not damage trees, shrubs, platforms or environment; treat other anglers with respect.

Please take all rubbish home or place in the bins provided.

No night fishing (unless particular authorisation has been granted: no guests allowed during night fishing).

Disinfect your nets on arrival, if not completely dry on arrival.

Fishing is from constructed pegs at platforms only. Anglers must reel in if you leave your peg.

Barbless hooks only. 2 kilos of ground bait maximum.

Fish over 4lb should not be placed in the keep net or sack.

Unhooking mats are required for large fish, max 12lb line. Return fish to the water carefully and promptly.

All fish caught are to be returned to the lake, removal of fish from the site will result in prosecution.

Retrieve broken line/tackle which may cause injury or death to fish or wildlife.

Please beware slipping / tripping hazards (including lines, etc).

Snack items (and other food products) available from Farm Shop.

Anglers found to be continuously in breach of any of the above may at the discretion of Jon Thorner be asked to leave the site. Re-offenders will not be permitted. Dropping of litter is considered as a serious breach of the Rules.
