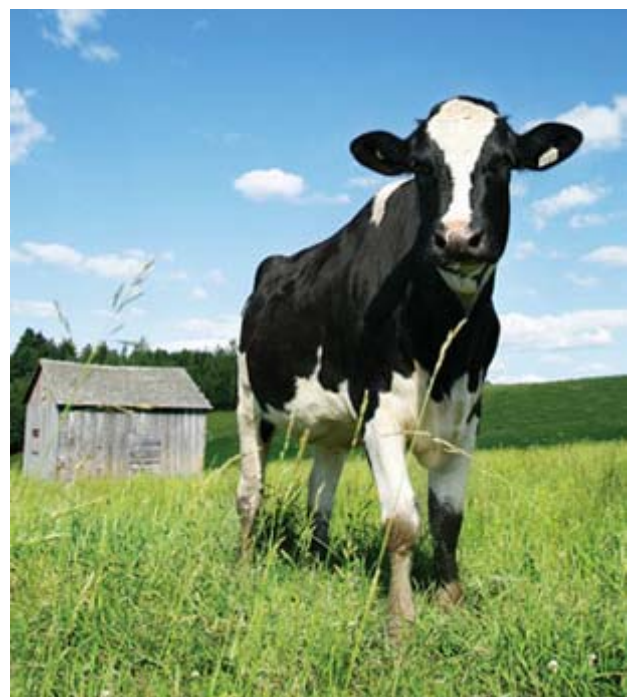
Jon Thorner's are regularly in the media on a regional scale. Below are a few examples of what we get involved in:
